Choir	Tuesday 3:15-4:15 Junior hall	1-6	£9 for 9 weeks	For those that enjoy singing. We welcome singers of all abilities, and the only requirement is to have a passion for music. You will also have the opportunity to perform at various events throughout the year. With Mrs Titchener and Mrs Harri.
Arts and Crafts	Tuesday 3:15-4:15 Kingfisher	1-3	£40.50 for 9 weeks	Various arts and crafts activities some of which your child will bring home. Open to Year 3 this term but maximum numbers still apply. With Mrs Hurst and Mrs Nelson-Williams.
Taskmaster (Min numbers apply)	Wednesday 3:15-4:15 Junior hall	3-6	£30 for 6 weeks	In Taskmaster Club, the children are the contestants, whilst the adult takes on the role of the Taskmaster, ably assisted by Little Alex Horne himself. Each session includes 4 tasks to develop children's problem-solving and reasoning skills, as well as building teamwork, creativity, and resilience. There are tasks to suit every child, challenges for all, plus lots (and lots) of fun! With Mr Andrews and Mr Pullen.
Stage club	Thursday 3:15-4:15 Junior hall	1-6	£40.50 for 9 weeks	Fun activities encompassing acting, singing and dancing, aimed at building resilience and teamwork. With Miss Arnold and other support staff.
Code Club	Thursday 3.15-4.15 Junior classroom	3-6	£40.50 for 9 weeks	Code Club is a global network of coding clubs for children and young people that provides free online projects developed in Scratch, Python, and HTML/CSS. Using these projects, children create cool and fun games, animations, and websites, while learning the key concepts of programming. Run by our parent volunteer Livia Stacey and Miss Ryan.

A Microsoft e-form will be sent out via email on **Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> January at 6pm** for completion. You will not be able to book a space before that. **The form will be switched off at midnight on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> January.** 

Places are available on a strictly first come, first serve basis on receipt of the e-form. If you are allocated a place, it will appear on Arbor during the day by **Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> at 3pm**. Full payment is required by **Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> January** unless an instalment arrangement has been made with the office. If we do not receive payment by that date, the space will be allocated to the next person on the waiting list. Refunds will not be given unless there is an exceptional circumstance agreed by myself.

Where we are charging for clubs, these charges cover resources to allow the clubs to run. Please note that all clubs will run from 3:15pm to 4:15pm this term.

Please be reminded of the Federation's 50% subsidy for one club for Pupil Premium children. If your child is entitled to the 50% subsidy, please make this clear when you are returning your form and we can then check the entitlement on our computer system and record your payment accordingly. We can offer this subsidy for Stage Club, Code Club and Arts and Crafts but will be unable to offer it for Choir or Taskmaster as we are charged the resources externally.
